Overview:

Regional Planning and Coordination: The Regional Planning and Coordination Workgroup is responsible for coordinating local efforts and strategic initiatives to end homelessness within Jackson County.

Duties

- 1) Contributing to, reviewing, and integrating local consolidated plans from Ashland and Medford into strategies and policies to end homelessness in Jackson County
- 2) Ensuring the CoC Board has established an effective strategic planning process
- 3) Coordinating CoC goals and activities with other outside entities working to address homelessness in Jackson County
- 4) Planning for and conducting the annual Point-In-Time Count of homeless persons and Housing Inventory Count within Jackson County, which meets the most current HUD requirements
- 5) Recommending funding priorities for the annual CoC Competition
- 6) Completing annual gaps analysis report in collaboration with CoC Lead Agency; and
- 7) Overseeing the work of its standing sub-workgroup, the Transition Policy Workgroup.
