- 2) **Community Updates**
 - a) Medford Severe Weather Shelter
 - i) A total of 1560 people were served at the Medford Severe Weather Shelter during the storm.
 - b) Columbia Care
 - i) No “Third Thursday” this month at Columbia Care.
 - c) ACCESS’ Senior Fair
 - i) The Senior Fair will be at a new location this year.
 - (1) The fair will be on April 8th Rogue X.
 - d) Rogue Retreat
 - i) Heather’s Haven is temporarily closed.
- 3) **Aging and Disability Resource Connection Overview Presentation**
 - a) Serves Jackson and Josephine Counties.
 - i) Provides resources for seniors (ages 60 and older), and disabled adults under 60.
 - b) Core Services include:
 - i) Caregivers, nutrition, health and wellness, and supportive services.
 - c) Options for Long-Term Care:
 - i) Home-based, community-based, and facility-based services.
- 4) **Strategic Plan Roadmap 2025 - 2027**
 - a) Improve information systems: inventory housing/service assets, progress coordinated entry, enhance data collection
 - b) Enhance communication: develop media campaign, create COC standards/shared language, form DEI workgroup
 - c) Expand homeless services: feasibility study for resource campus, develop housing retention support, create opportunities for unhoused families
 - d) Develop funding sources: business model for resource campus, identify non-governmental support, align services with county/city requests
- 5) **Point In Time (PIT) Count Review**
 - a) The PIT count was completed at the end of January, and it went well.
 - b) There are no final numbers yet, and the results are still being processed.
